Becoming a volunteer with STRIDE at Catamount is a wonderful opportunity to meet really great people; experience exciting challenges; learn and improve skiing & riding skills; contribute to your community, and have fun! Although volunteers do not receive monetary compensation for duties performed, the equivalent compensations in the form of season's passes, lift tickets, etc. are part of the benefits you receive. STRIDE will do its best to equip its volunteers with the skills and knowledge necessary to have a very rewarding experience. In return, we ask volunteers to take their commitment to STRIDE, Catamount and the students we assist very seriously.

Eligibility

- You must be minimum 15 years old to be a teaching volunteer; under 18 requires state working papers, school and parental approval. A STRIDE consent form must be on file.
- You must possess low intermediate skiing/riding skills.
- You must **commit to attend a minimum of one weekend day (Saturday or Sunday) for the entire season, as well as the pre-season training.**
