Freestyle Program

This program is for Season Pass holders, ages 18 and under, with the ability to ski or ride the mountain. All abilities of freestyle, from intro to advanced, are welcome. If you are interested in improving your talents, here's your chance. This program integrates physical skill development and safety awareness, with a great opportunity to make new friends. Coaches combine fun and challenge to develop the techniques needed to pull off freestyle maneuvers in both disciplines. Those interested in competing at other mountains must join the USASA. The Catamount Freestyle program is a great way to enjoy lots of fun moments and (for those qualifying) a chance to compete against other local teams. You get all of this for a registration fee of only **\$275**.

Interclub Race Program

If your child is seeking a challenge beyond the Mountain Cats program, may we suggest inquiring about our Interclub Racing Program? This season-long weekend program provides almost 30 days of participation including race days. Our racing staff will work with your child to teach the finer techniques of skiing and racing as well as competing against other Berkshire Mountain race programs. A season pass is required.

Children's Playroom

If you have a child that doesn't ski or ride, is between the ages of 2 and 6 years of age, and is toilet trained, then Catamount's Children's Playroom may be what you're looking for when you want to hit the slopes yourself. Activities include toys and age appropriate videos. Children **MUST** be toilet trained. Sorry, **NO exceptions**.

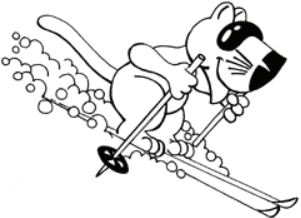

Great things continue at Catamount. After adding a 2nd Wonder Carpet lift for Mountain Cats last year, we have provided more access to beginner terrain this year by connecting the easier Upper Promenade trail to the top of the easier Esplanade trail.

With the most green circle "easier" trails in the Berkshires, The Meadows Beginner Area, served by The Meadows Triple Chairlift, features 11 trails, 7 of which are green circle "easier" trails. The mile-long Upper & Lower Promenade run, Holiday, Esplanade, and Colonel's Caper are very popular trails for Mountain Cats. Soon kids progress to Catamount's summit where they are ready to take on the more difficult Ridge Run trail and the mile-long Sidewinder run.

VARIETY FOR THE WHOLE FAMILY

In addition to the Meadows Beginner Area, Catamount features a diverse trail network with long cruisers, challenging black diamond trails and the double black diamond Catapult expert run. Freestylers enjoy 3 terrain parks and a halfpipe. There is snowmaking on 31 trails and grooming every day. Catamount is **real mountain fun, real close to home.**

Mountain Cats Registration

You will need to register for the Mountain Cats program in the Berkshire Lodge. Come directly into the lodge entrance facing the parking lot and head up the stairs. The registration area is immediately to your left.

Full Day Program: 9:30am—3:30pm
\$100—Includes lift ticket, instruction, lunch and 2 snacks.

Half Day Program: 9:30am—12pm or 1pm—3:30pm
\$75—Includes lift ticket, instruction and 1 snack

If you register for a half day in the morning and wish to continue for the afternoon session, the additional cost is \$25 and will not include lunch.

2 Consecutive full days: \$180
2 Consecutive half days: \$140

Children's skis and snowboards can be rented in the Mountain Cats meeting area where we have over 100 pairs of skis and 30 boards. There is no need to go to our Main Rental Shop for your child's equipment.
